FFTA SPONSORED RECEPTION FOLLOWING THE SHOW

Amateur-owned Performance Classes—Rider is owner of the horse./Riders are 18+ years.

Open Classes—Except where noted, classes are open to all age horses and participants.

Model Classes—Horses are to be judged on the conformation of the horses.

Fun Classes--Open to all ages of horses and riders

Pleasure/Versatility Classes--Except where noted, open to all age horses and all participants

Youth—Youth may not show stallions./Youth riders are required to wear helmets.

(For this show the 5 Amateur-owned classes will abide by the new MFTHBA rules which state that the Amateur exhibitor must be the owner of the horse. In cases of co-ownership, the co-owner must be a member of the rider's immediate family. In order to enter an Amateur-owned class, the exhibitor must bring the horse's registration papers for verification of ownership.)
